Below is a list of applicable scholarships to apply to this month. Some scholarships are need-based, some are merit-based, and some have specific eligibility requirements. Please make sure to check carefully that you meet all requirements before beginning your application. Feel free to apply to as many as you can!

MIT Think Out Of The Box Scholars Program

- **Deadline:** January 1, 2021
- **Amount:** \$1000
- **Qualifying Applications:** You must be a full-time high school student (i.e. attending a public, private, or home school) at the time of your application
- **Application Requirements:** Submit your proposal: upload your project proposal, making sure to follow the instructions outlined below in Proposal Guidelines

One Earth Film Festival Young Filmmakers Contest

- **Deadline:** January 5, 2021
- **Amount:** \$350 and matching \$350 grant for 9, 10, and 11th. \$1000 and \$1000 grant for 12th.
- **Qualifying Applications:** Be in high school
- **Application Requirements:** Requirements are dependent on grade level of the student applying.

GE Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program

- **Deadline:** January 5, 2021
- **Amount:** \$10,000
- **Qualifying Applications:** Be current high school seniors attending high school in the United States (students living on U.S. Armed Forces base and homeschooled students are also eligible); and plan to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study toward a bachelor's degree at an accredited four-year college or university in the United States for the entire upcoming academic year.

Foot Locker Scholar Athletes Program

- **Deadline:** January 8, 2021
- **Amount:** \$20,000 to 20 students
- **Qualifying Applications:** The Foot Locker Scholar Athletes program honors student-athletes who demonstrate exceptional academic ability and strong leadership skills in sports, in their schools, and within their communities.
- **Application Requirements:** Tell them how you are a leader on and off the field.

Diller Tikkun Olam Awards

- **Deadline:** January 8, 2021
- **Amount:** \$36,000
- **Qualifying Applications:** Serving in a leadership role on a project aimed at repairing the world, Aged 13-19, Self-identified as Jewish, Residents of the United States, Volunteering without any compensation
- **Application Requirements:** Complete application

Profile in Courage Essay Contest

- **Deadline:** January 15, 2021
- **Amount:** \$10,000 for first place
- **Qualifying Applications:** The contest is open to United States high school students in grades nine through twelve attending public, private, parochial, or home schools; U.S. students under the age of twenty enrolled in a high school correspondence/GED program in any of the fifty states, the District of Columbia, or the U.S. territories; and U.S. citizens attending schools overseas. Past winners and finalists are not eligible to participate. Employees of John Hancock Financial Services and members of their families are not eligible to participate.
- **Application Requirements:** Original work essay

Carson Scholars Fund

- **Deadline:** January 15, 2021
- **Amount:** \$1000
- **Qualifying Applications:** Be in grade 4-11 and be nominated by a current educator
- **Application Requirements:** Be nominated by an educator before the respective date

Baer Reintegration Scholarship

- **Deadline:** January 15, 2021
- **Amount:** Varies
- **Qualifying Applications:** Be diagnosed with bipolar disorder, schizophrenia or schizoaffective disorder. Be currently receiving medical treatment for the disease, including medications and psychiatric follow-up, or have treating physician's documentation of past history noted on Recommendation Form. Be actively involved in rehabilitative or reintegration efforts, such as clubhouse membership, part-or full-time employment, volunteer efforts or school enrollment. Be age 18 years or older by September 1st, 2021.

Coolidge Scholarship

- **Deadline:** January 20, 2021
- **Amount:** \$1000
- **Qualifying Applications:** 2021 Coolidge Scholarship applicants must intend to enroll full-time at an accredited U.S. college or university as an undergraduate for the first time in fall 2022. That is to say, students in their junior year of high school, or the equivalent if home schooled, are eligible to apply. (Students who are currently high school juniors but take some courses at a local college are indeed eligible to apply for the Coolidge Scholarship.)

Live Mas Scholarship

- **Deadline:** January 20, 2021
- **Amount:** Up to \$25,000
- **Qualifying Applications:** Applicant is a legal resident of the 50 United States and the District of Columbia ("D.C.") who is at least 16 years of age and no older than 26 years of age as of the last day of the Program Period located in the United States or D.C.
- **Application Requirements:** Create a video answering the three question requirements

APCA College Scholarship

- **Deadline:** February 1, 2021
- **Amount:** Up to \$4,000
- **Qualifying Applications:** Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors and current college students who have a diagnosis of cleft lip and/or cleft palate or other congenital craniofacial difference). Preference will be given to rising first-year students in any field and to currently enrolled students in a field of study related to cleft or craniofacial conditions (e.g. genetic counseling, speech-language pathology).

- **Amount:** Varies
- **Qualifying Applications:** Contest is open to students in grades 6 through 12 and undergraduate students.
- **Application Requirements:** Students must submit an essay based on an interview with a woman currently working in a mathematical career.

- **Amount:** \$5000
